Straddling the Trans-Canada Trail and with over 20 km of our own trails through mixed terrain of white pine, fir and deciduous forest, The centre is a beautiful and peaceful setting for learning, reflection and outdoor activities in all four seasons.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Upon arrival In order to reduce traffic at the entrance and at our reception, we ask your group to appoint one or two representatives to check-in. Others should wait outside or near the vehicles.

Check-in - Check-in time is 4:00 pm, but feel free to come to check in early and enjoy the property until your accommodations are ready.

Parking - Please park your car in the designated parking areas and walk to your accommodation. Parking areas can be found on the map.

WHILE YOU'RE HERE

Visitor Rules & Guidelines

Boundaries - Only camp staff are allowed in certain areas of the camp. These areas are the workshop, white pine kitchen, tuck shop, upper-boathouse, staff residences, trip room, craft hut, infirmary, and train station.

Age Limitations - Rental sites and units are only rented to persons over the age of 18, any person under the age of 18 must be under the supervision of a parent or guardian. Groups under the age of 18 must have a responsible leader in each rental space.

Campfires - Campfires are only allowed in designated fire pits and must be kept reasonably low. Before leaving make sure your fire is out. Buckets are provided at each campsite for this purpose.

Pets - pets are allowed in all campsites and buildings excluding White Pine Lodge. A \$75 pet cleaning fee will be charged for pets in rented buildings. Dogs must be kept on a leash, except on hiking trails where they can run free. Please pick up after your pet.

Excessive Noise - Please keep music and other media at a low volume. Camp-wide quiet time is from 11 pm to 7 am.

Insurance - Gracefield does not provide insurance for personal belongings or your group's liability. You must provide your own.

WHILE YOU'RE HERE

Visitor Rules & Guidelines

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Substances - Alcohol is discouraged and only permitted in your rental space. Alcohol is not allowed in the dining hall except when given permission from the Camp Manager. Smoking is only permitted at outdoor fire pits. No guest shall possess, consume, or be under the influence of any illegal drugs.

Damage - Please impress upon your group the importance of showing respect for the natural environment, site, and facilities. Visitors are held responsible for any damage done to the property. Please report any damages to the office.

Rental units - Please keep out of any rental units or sites not booked by you or your group, unless invited by the renter.

Fishing - Fishing is only allowed at the Boathouse, Beaver jetty, and Jolly Roger jetty. A provincial fishing licence is required and can be purchased at the Ultramar gas station in town.

Motors - Motorboats, motorized trail bikes, all-terrain vehicles, and snowmobiles are not allowed as they are not compatible with our programming.

Services

Meals - We offer an 8:30 am Breakfast, 12:30 pm lunch, 5:30 pm Dinner, and 11:00 am Sunday bunch. If you plan on eating with us please book in advance for each meal. Certain Dietary restrictions can be accommodated.

- Breakfast - 10.50\$
- Lunch/Brunch - 12.50\$
- Dinner - 18\$

Worship - All guests are welcome to join us for worship on Sundays at 10:00 am in the chapel (July - August).

Tuck Shop - (Candy & Camp Souvenirs) The Tuck Shop is on the playing field and is open Saturdays and Sundays from 1:30-2:00 pm, or by request at the main office.

Laundry - Laundry facilities are available at Jolly Roger.

Firewood - Deadfall is always recommended as firewood and can be collected around the site at no charge. Each campsite or cabin will come with one load of firewood, extra firewood can be purchased from the office at the cost of \$10/wagon. From Sept 16th-May 14th firewood is free for lodge fireplaces.

First Aid - Gracefield has a qualified first aider on call at all times, first aid kits are also present in every lodge.

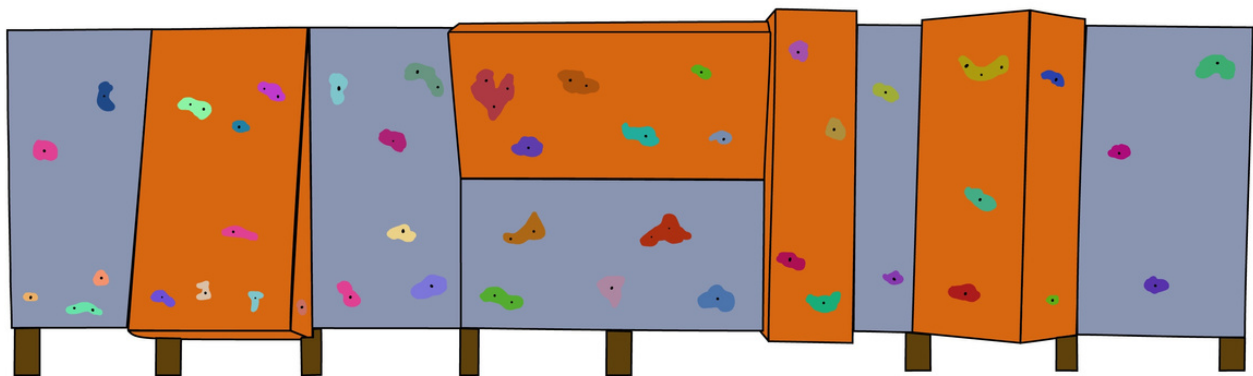

 - 25\$ per hour

 - 10\$/hour - 25\$/day (Max 3 people per canoe)

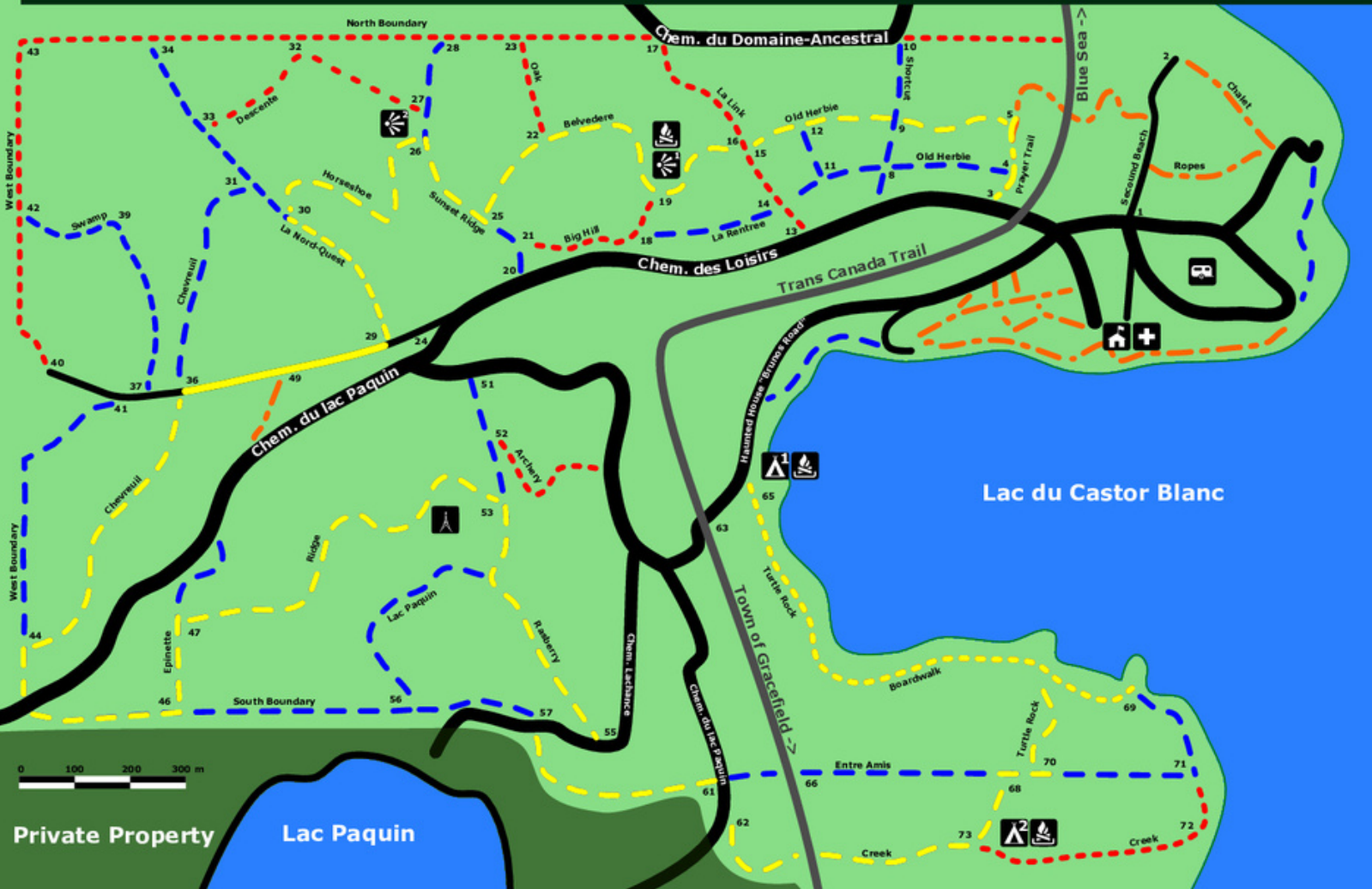
